
DID YOU KNOW?

The Wapasu Lake Conservancy Park near Innisfree is a joint undertaking to preserve and protect the wildlife habitat known in and around the Lake. Wapasu Lake (Cree for white swan) is a known migratory stop for white swans, and countless wildlife species. Included in this project is the development of 8 kilometers of multi-use nature trails, bird viewing sites, and restored native botanical sites. Trails are now developed to the summit of the natural elevation that provides a panoramic view of the lake and surrounding area for you to enjoy.
