	Hamlets of Ranfurly, Lavoy, and Minburn	75%
Gravel Roads	All	100%

* NOTICE *

A TAC Permit is required for tridem axles or loads exceeding a GVW of 53,500 kg. This permit allows tridem axles and/or vehicle configuration with a GVW greater than 53,500 kg to operate on local roads at the same legal maximum weights as on Provincial Highways, as per Alberta Regulation 315/2002. A tridem axle is restricted to 17,000 kg on any municipal roadway unless a TAC permit is acquired.
