POLICY: **DUST CONTROL WITH CALCIUM
ON ROADS IN FRONT OF FARMYARD SITES**



POLICY NO.: **PW 12**
POLICY EFFECTIVE: **March 16, 2009**

The County of Minburn No. 27 may provide dust control with calcium on County roads fronting yard sites at the request of a resident subject to the following conditions:

- a) Maximum distance to be dust controlled is areas of 900 feet long by 24 feet wide;
- b) That each area 400 feet long by 24 feet wide, there shall be a charge of \$525.00 includes G.S.T.; that each area 600 feet long by 24 feet wide, there shall be a charge of \$787.50 includes G.S.T.; that each area 900 feet long by 24 feet wide, there shall be a charge of \$1,181.25 includes G.S.T. (*per application*) to the applying resident; or
- c) Where a yard site is situated near an intersection, dust control on the road fronting (*400 feet*) and flanking (*400 feet*) the yard, there shall be a charge of \$525.00 includes G.S.T. (*per application*);
- d) Payment shall be made in advance on a pre-paid basis, by the applying resident, to the County Administration Office in Vegreville;
- e) If possible, the applications received will be grouped to allow more than one project in a specific area;
- f) The County reserves the right to limit the amount of applications per year;
- g) Dust Control applications accepted until May 18. After May 18, the Superintendent of Public Works has the discretion to accept applications.
- h) Dust Control Agreement is only valid for the current season.
- i) Calcium cannot be applied to previous oil dust controls. Some exceptions may apply with the approval of the Superintendent of Public Works.
- j) **Dust control services will be maintained or reclaimed to gravel at any time deemed necessary at the discretion of the Superintendent of Public Works.**

Any previous policy relative to Dust Control on roads in front of yard sites is hereby rescinded.
