POLICY: DUST CONTROL WITH CALCIUM AND OIL
ON ROADS IN FRONT OF YARD SITES

POLICY NO.: PW 44
POLICY EFFECTIVE: March 14, 2019



Purpose:

To provide rural residents in the County of Minburn with the option to have dust control applied to County roads adjacent to their residences on a cost share basis.

Policy Guidelines:

1. The County of Minburn will advertise dust control application procedures annually. Payment in full is to be submitted with the application.
2. All requests for dust control shall be made to the County of Minburn Administration office on or before the annual date specified by the Superintendent of Public Works.
3. The applicant will enter into a Dust Control Agreement with the County prior to commencement of the dust control application.
4.
 - a) Oil dust control will be applied in increments of 300 feet, 600 feet and 900 feet.
 - b) Calcium dust control will be applied in increments of 400 feet, 600 feet and 900 feet.
5. The cost for dust control applications will be determined annually by the Superintendent of Public Works on the basis of fifty (50) percent cost recovery to the County of Minburn.
6. The cost of dust control will be made known to applicants on application forms prior to entering a Dust Control Agreement with the County.
7. The dust control abatement product applied under the Dust Control Agreement is intended to last for the current calendar year only and the County offers no warranty on the longevity or the effectiveness of the dust suppression agent.
8. The County of Minburn reserves the right to maintain or remove dust control applications on roadways, as necessitated, to ensure the safety of the travelling public is not jeopardized.
9. The County of Minburn reserves the right to limit the amount of dust control applications approved each year.
