Vegreville Transportation Services Society

At Vegreville Transportation Services Society, we have a vision. We see VTSS ensuring community supported accessible and affordable transportation to the residents of Vegreville and area.

VTSS was formed from a group of responsible community members and organizations concerned about transportation issues within the Vegreville area.

VTSS is sustained by volunteers, community partnerships and fundraising to address and provide transportation solutions to eligible individuals. VTSS has pursued this mission by launching the taxi voucher program in 2004 and beginning Handivan service in 2005.

HANDIVAN PROGRAM

The handivan program is a much needed asset in our community. This is a service which provides wheelchair accessible transportation to those who require. The residents of our area often need to travel to regional medical facilities to access specialist services. VTSS provides transportation to these facilities.

TAXI VOUCHER PROGRAM

Financial assistance is provided to those who utilize the taxi service through the taxi voucher program. Clients are provided with taxi vouchers to use towards their transportation costs. VTSS clients are eligible for one booklet of 10 vouchers every six weeks.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Subsidy will be provided to those who qualify through an application process.

Senior (65 years of age or older)

Disability - anyone who has a permanent or temporary disability which prevents them from using standard methods of transportation with comfort and ease. Persons with a permanent disability and receiving Disability pension or AISH must present documentation upon application.

Financial Barriers— persons experiencing financial hardship that limits their ability in accessing local transportation. Financial documentation must be presented upon application.
